IN ACTION DURING THE BATTLE OF THE BULGE**

**Tec 5 Eugene C. BARRETT (A Co)** courageous performance of duty, while evacuating casualties in ambulance, under enemy fire, 16 December 1944 in the vicinity of Krinkelt, Belgium – awarded Bronze Star Medal 3 January 1945

**Capt John M. McRAE (324th Med Bn Hq)** courageous action, good judgment, excellent leadership, in evacuation of casualties by leading truck convoy loaded with wounded thru enemy artillery fire between Krinkelt, Belgium and Nidrum, Belgium, 16 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Capt Thomas A. EGAN (C Co)** for meritorious service in command of C Company during the period 16-20 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 8 January 1945

**Capt Anthony J. LENTINE (A Co)** for meritorious service in command of A Company during the period 16-20 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 30 January 1945

**S/Sgt Paul R. PRIEL (C Co)** for bravery and leadership in evacuation of 20 seriously wounded men from Rocherath and Krinkelt, Belgium, in the face of enemy fire, 17 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 30 January 1945

**S/Sgt Arthur E. WHITE (C Co)** evacuation of casualties under heavy enemy fire in the vicinity of Rocherath, Belgium, 17 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Tec 5 Wayne W. ISAACSON (B Co)** volunteered to search for and evacuate wounded soldier in Krinkelt, Belgium, after Germans had infiltrated and during enemy artillery fire, 17 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Pfc Donald C. Johnson (C Co)** evacuation of casualties under heavy enemy fire in the vicinity of Rocherath, Belgium, 17 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Pfc José G. NAVARRO (A Co)** evacuation of casualties by ambulance thru heavy artillery fire and area which German snipers had infiltrated, 17-19 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**S/Sgt Frank J. LONGOBARDI (C Co)** remained with wounded men, rendering first aid, organized litter squad for their evacuation under fire in the vicinity of Krinkelt, Belgium, 18 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Tec 3 William K. TUCKER (C Co)** volunteered to remain in Rocherath, Belgium, to treat wounded and to evacuate them by straggling vehicles, after C Company had withdrawn, 18 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Sgt Drayton M. CLARY Jr (C Co)** volunteered to remain in Rocherath, Belgium, to treat wounded and to evacuate them by straggling vehicles, after C Company had withdrawn, 18 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 5 January 1945

**Pfc Robert J. HART (C Co)** for initiative and heroic conduct in evacuating 27 members of C Company and another 2 wounded soldiers by making five trips in a ¼-Ton Truck between Rocherath and Krinkelt, Belgium, thru artillery and small arms fire 18 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 30 January 1945

**S/Sgt Harold X. ETTER (C Co)** for heroic action in organizing and leading 2 litter squads to evacuate casualties thru artillery and small arms fire in the vicinity of Rocherath, Belgium, 18 December 1944 – awarded Bronze Star Medal 30 January 1945
